The Peace Conference Agreement. The following is the plan finally agreed upon by the Peace Conference, recently assembled at Washington, for an adjustment of our national differences.

Section 1. In all the present territory of the United States north of the parallel of thirty degrees and thirty minutes of north latitude, and south of the parallel of thirty degrees and thirty minutes of north latitude, no slavery shall be permitted.

Section 2. The territory shall be acquired by the United States by discovery and for equal and commercial stations, depots, and transit routes, without the concurrence of a majority of all the Senators from States which possess territory.

Section 3. Neither the Constitution, nor any amendment thereof, shall be so construed as to require the United States to acquire territory by purchase, or to prohibit the acquisition of territory by purchase.
