ARTICLE I. BILL OF RIGHTS. The declaration of rights, as amended and passed to this Constitution, shall have the same force and effect as if it had been passed by the former Legislature.

ARTICLE II. DIVISION OF POWERS. The legislative, executive and judicial departments shall be separate and distinct, no one shall exercise the powers properly belonging to either of the others...

ARTICLE III. QUALIFICATION OF VOTERS. Every white male citizen of the Commonwealth of the age of twenty-one years, who has been a resident of the county...

ARTICLE IV. LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT. The Legislature shall be formed of two distinct branches, which together shall be called the General Assembly of Virginia.

ARTICLE V. HOUSE OF DELEGATES. One of three shall be called the House of Delegates, and shall consist of one hundred and fifty members...

ARTICLE VI. SENATE. The other shall be called the Senate, and consist of thirty members, for the election of whom the counties, cities, and towns shall be divided into fifty districts...

ARTICLE VII. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT. The Executive Department shall consist of the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Justices of the Supreme Court...

ARTICLE VIII. JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT. The Judicial Department shall consist of the Supreme Court, the Circuit Courts, the County Courts, and the Justices of the Peace...

ARTICLE IX. ELECTORS. Every citizen of the Commonwealth of the age of twenty-one years, who has been a resident of the county...

ARTICLE X. ELECTIONS. The Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Justices of the Supreme Court shall be elected by the people...

ARTICLE XI. TERMS OF OFFICE. The Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Justices of the Supreme Court shall hold office for four years...

ARTICLE XII. SALARIES. The Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Justices of the Supreme Court shall receive salaries as determined by law...
