Further Particulars of the Battle in Kentucky, Jan. 28.

Yesterday's Louisville Journal says that the Union forces in Kentucky were routed on Saturday afternoon, making a forced march on Sunday morning, and on Monday morning were compelled to leave Bowling Green, in the morning, after having spent the night in the hills near the mouth of the Tennessee River. The Union people here looked on the battle-field in dismay, and are jubilant at the result. It is thought that the Confederates are to be defeated as a campaign.

CINCINNATI, Jan. 28. The Southern correspondence of the Times says that at 7 o'clock on Saturday morning the enemy drove in the pickets of the Tenth Indiana, stationed at the road, eight miles from Bowling Green. The Union pickets were routed, and driven into the woods, where they were met by the enemy, 6,000 strong, who instantly opened upon them. Gen. A report of the Missouri Adjutant-General shows that 34,882 troops of that State have entered the federal service for three years, and that the Missouri State Guard is now only 6,000 strong. The correspondence between Governor Andrew and Gen. Butler and the Department, relative to the enlistment in Maine of soldiers, which has been held before the Legislature, comprises 77 letters and several telegrams. Gov. Andrew is much dissatisfied with the result, and has been made independently of his authority and regards it as illegal.

An order has been issued, allowing the War Department, on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, against all business but that which relates to military operations in the field. The main object in Kentucky is now said to be ready to advance, the weather presenting the only obstacle.

A recently passed bill by the Confederate Congress is said to prohibit the publication of war news in the papers.
